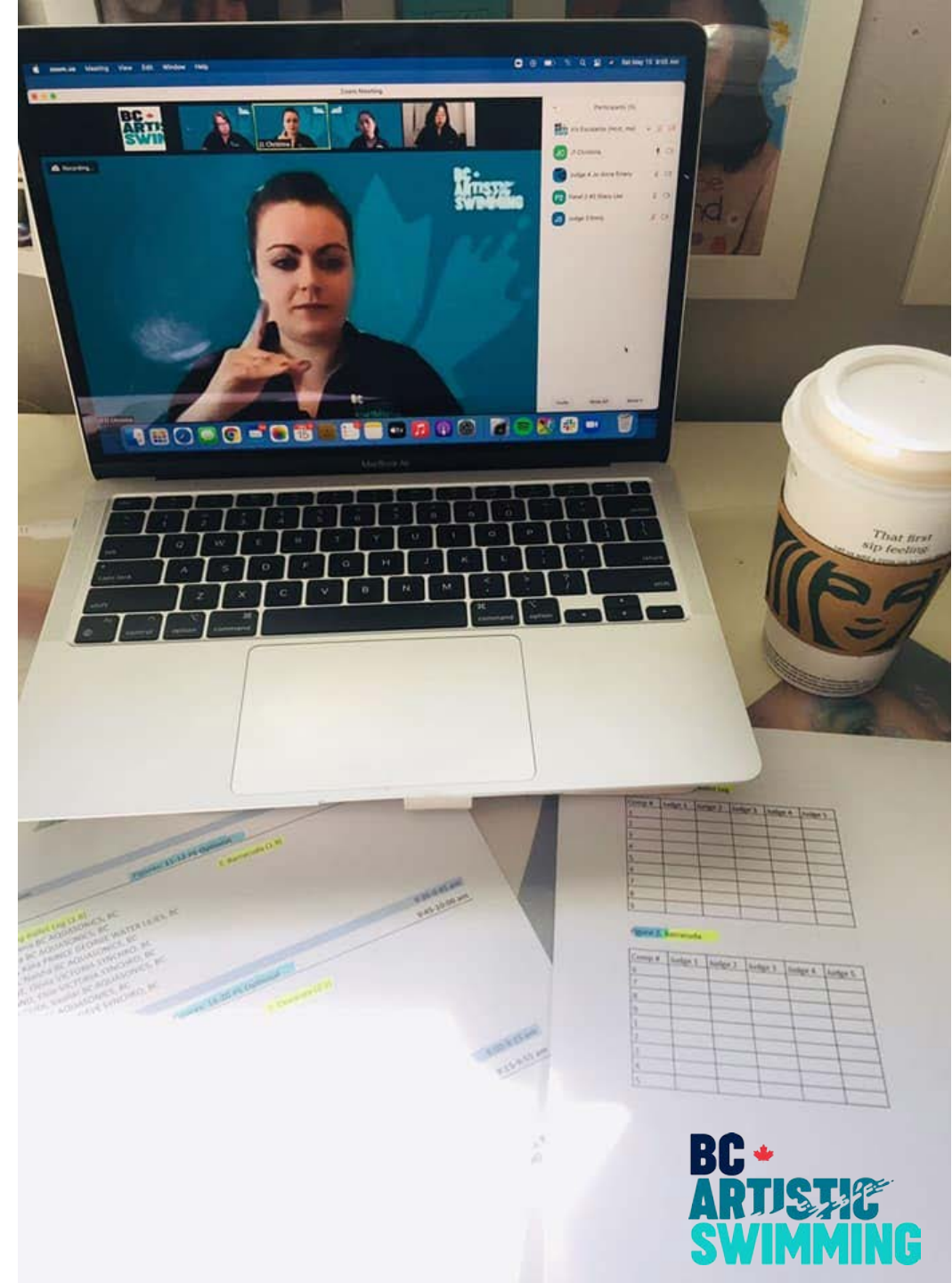
What is the JCP?

New development model that changes how training and judge feedback is delivered during early preparatory phases of the season.

Panel of judges works directly with club for designated period of time to provide feedback and support in:

- 🇨🇦 Figures
- 🇨🇦 Elements
- 🇨🇦 Basic Skills
- 🇨🇦 Routines

Mixed level panels supports judge, coach and athlete development.





What is the JCP?

- 🇨🇦 Designed in Fall 2021 for the 2022-23 season
- 🇨🇦 Fast-tracked pilot with NS Clubs after TM cancellations

2021-22 Pilot Program:

- 4 clubs
- 13 judges

What is the JCP?

Judge Panels

- ✿ Assigned by BCAS
- ✿ 4-5 judges/panel, span of levels
- ✿ Each panel works with 1-2 clubs
- ✿ 2 panel rotations
 - ✿ November – December
 - ✿ January – March
- ✿ Designated Head Judge but panel is a unit with all included in communications and activities



What is the JCP?

Judge Panels

- Clubs receive 3 hours of judges' time per month
- Head Coach & Head Judge determine plan
- May include real-time streamed club visit, on-site visit, video review sessions, other
- \$100/month per club
- BCAS covers all travel expenses
