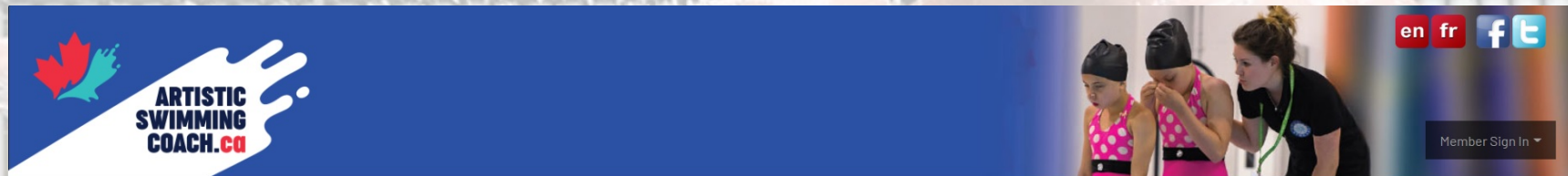

Canada Artistic Swimming - Coach Development Pathway

(Effective January 1, 2024) ←

Regarding NCCP Make Ethical Decisions "MED": Effective September 1, 2020 instructors/coaches are REQUIRED to take NCCP Make Ethical Decisions TRAINING (3.5 hour module delivered by Provincial/Territorial Coaching Association) as part of their required training (as per our CAS Coach Development Pathway for AquaGO!, Comp Intro & Comp Dev). Note that CAC states "Any coach requiring NCCP trained status will require the NCCP Make Ethical Decisions Training." Instructors/Coaches then complete MED online evaluation as an outcome of their Evaluation and Certification. Anyone who has completed MED online evaluation prior to September 1, 2020 is exempt - this is not retroactive.

The Locker maintains the records of a growing community of over 2 million coaches in Canada of coach training offered through the National Coaches Certification Program(NCCP) and its partners.

The Locker is also where your affiliated sport organization will confirm your completed training and coaching certifications, offer sport - specific eLearning, schedule events, and generate reports.

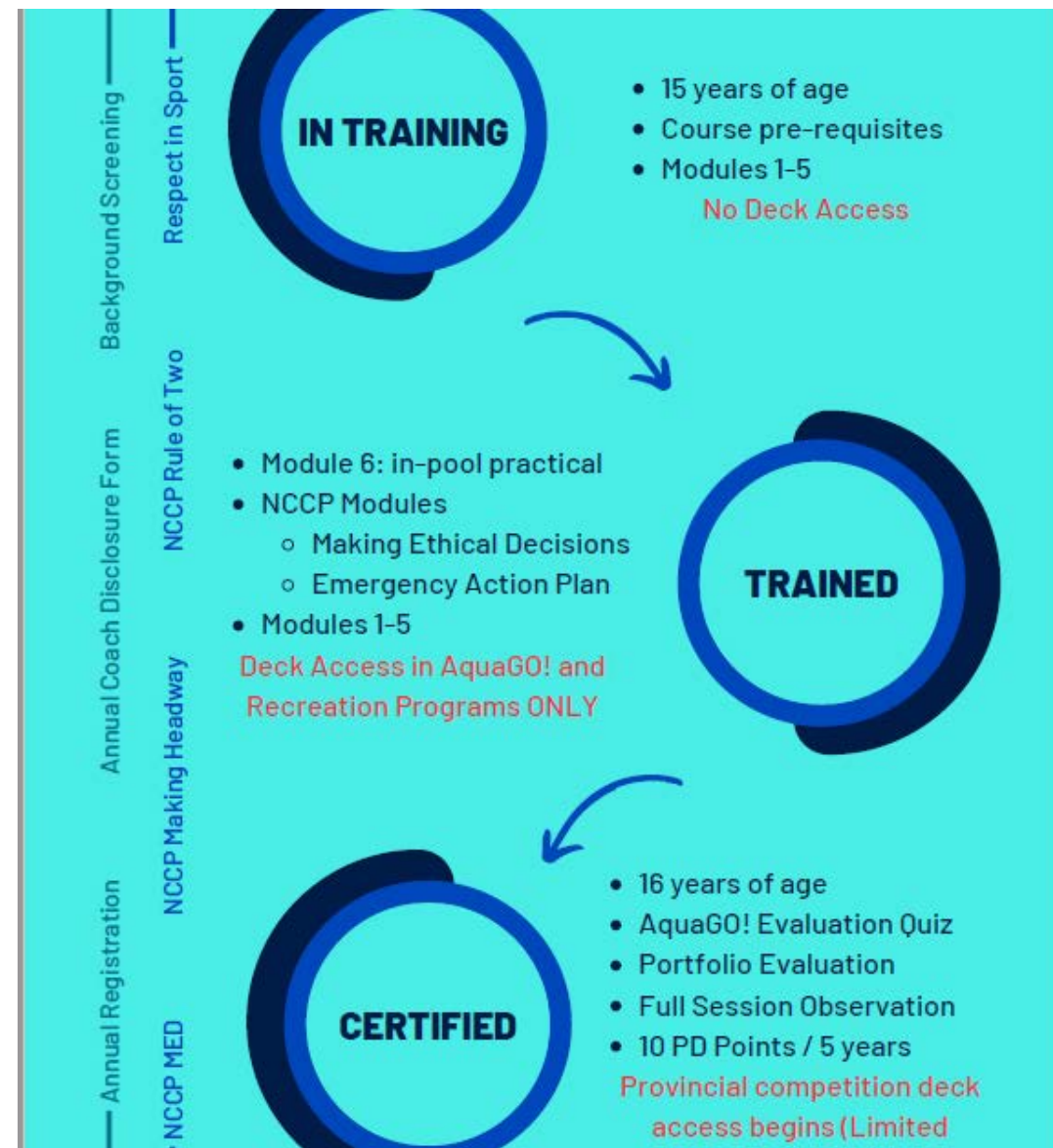

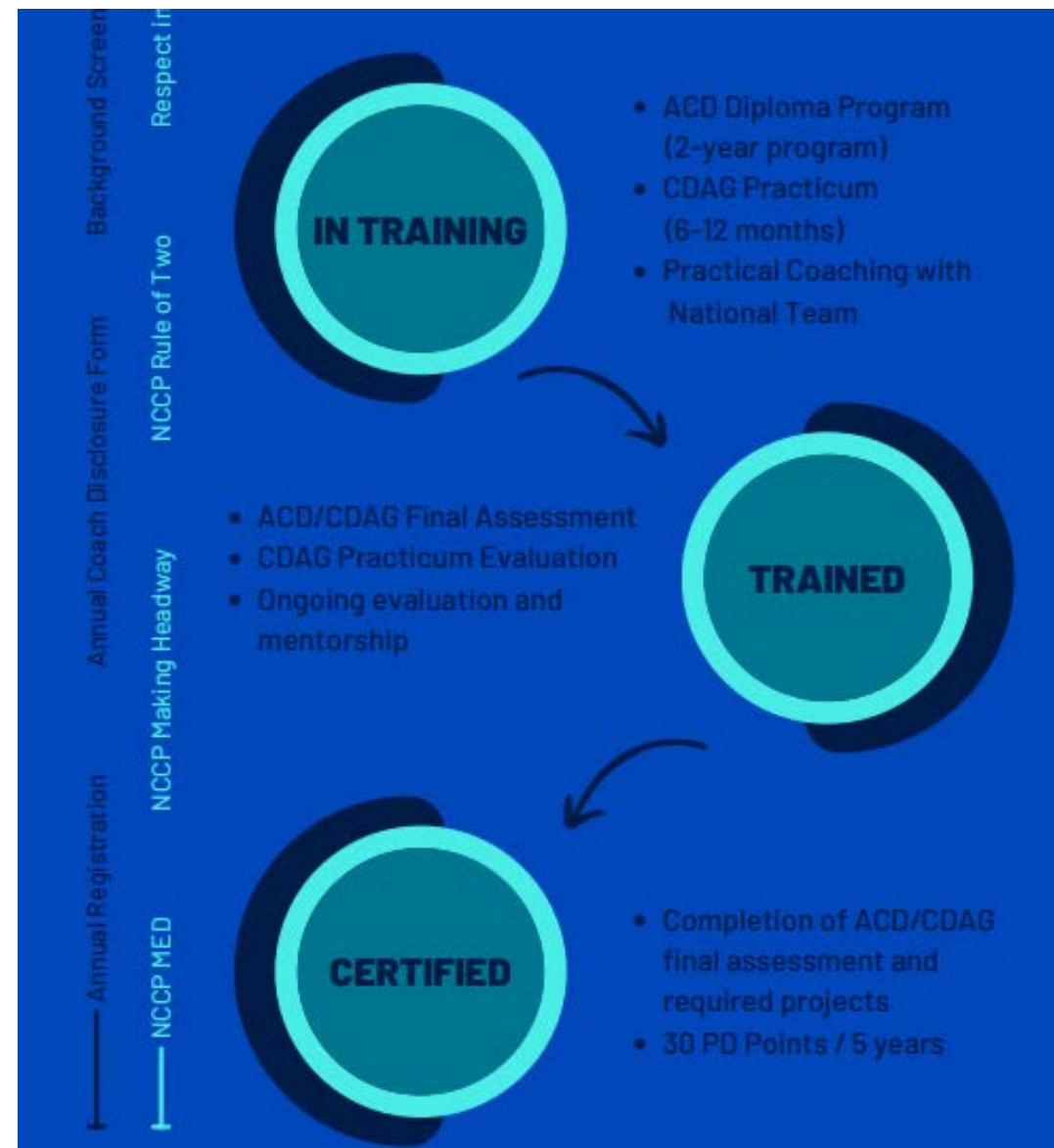

Coach Verification

BCAS Requirements:

1. BCAS receives completed coach registration for the new season
2. BCAS staff review and verify all standards are up to date and make note of any expiration dates within the upcoming season (September 1-August 31 the following year)
3. BCAS will notify clubs weekly (perhaps more during peak registration time) of coaches who are permitted to begin coaching for the new season

Coach Verification

Club Requirements and Expectations:

1. Upon receiving verification from BCAS, inform coach(es) when they are permitted to begin coaching for the new season.
2. Will not permit any coach to begin coaching without verification from BCAS.
3. If a new coach is hired at any time throughout the season, they will inform the coach of the registration process and requirements and not permit them on deck until verification from BCAS is received.

A CLUB'S SEASON CANNOT BEGIN UNTIL THEY HAVE RECEIVED VERIFICATION FROM BCAS OF PROPERLY CERTIFIED COACHES

Coaching Course Delivery Strategies

Clubs struggle to find certified coaches

Clubs/coaches inform BCAS of interest or BCAS does a call for interest

BCAS finds an LF, sets up the course and opens registration

Limited or no interest in course

BCAS cancels course
